This task describes how to use the [userutil](#) command to reset the [User password](#) for the preconfigured "admin" profile.

Procedure

1. Log in to the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace operating system as the mpadmin user.
2. At the password prompt, enter the mpadmin password.
The system displays the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace operating system desktop.
3. Right-click on the desktop.
4. From the menu, select **New Terminal**. This brings up a terminal session.
5. At the prompt, enter **userutil -p admin <newpassword>**.
6. On the desktop, click the Red Hat icon.
7. Click **Log Out**.
8. Click **OK**.
