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### Before You Begin

E-Mail Blasts will be sent using SMTP integration, make sure that the [SMTP Server Configuration Page](#) is properly configured.

### Procedure

1. Log in to the Administration Center.
2. Click **Maintenance > E-Mail Blast**.
3. Fill in the fields in [Table: Field Reference: E-Mail Blast Page](#).

**Table: Field Reference: E-Mail Blast Page**

Field	Description
Group	The user group to which you want to send the e-mail blast.  To send the e-mail blast to <i>all</i> users whose user profiles contain an e-mail address, choose ----- All -----.  Default: ----- None -----
Language	The language in which the e-mail blast is sent.  Default: English (US)
Subject	The subject of the e-mail blast.

	Default: Administrator announcement
Body	The text in the body of the e-mail blast.

4. Click **Send**.
