The SSL certificate that you upload must be in the PEM format. If your SSL certificate is in the DER format, convert it to the PEM format and upload it again. Use this CLI to convert a certificate from DER to PEM.

Procedure

- 1. Log in to the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express operating system as the **mpxadmin** user.
- 2. At the password prompt, enter the mpxadmin password.

 The Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express operating system desktop appears.
- 3. Right-click on the desktop.
- 4. From the menu, select **New Terminal**. This brings up a terminal session.
- 5. Enter the following command:

openssl x509 -in <'file1.crt'> -inform DER -out <'file2.crt'> [-outform PEM]

where *file1.crt* is the name of the DER file and *file2.crt* is the name of the PEM file. The [-outform PEM] is optional and defaults to PEM.

- 6. On the desktop, click **RedHat > Network Services**.
- 7. Click Log out.
