Field	Description	Value
<b>Exchange Server</b>		
Hostname	Hostname or IP address of the Microsoft Exchange Server. For Exchange 2007 use the hostname of server with Edge Transport Role.	Valid host name or IP address
Language	Used to support localized Exchange servers.	Any language installed on your system  Default: your system's default language
SSL enabled	Used to support Exchange servers that use SSL.	true/false  Default: false
<b>Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express Mailbox Account</b>		
Windows domain	Microsoft Windows domain. Obtain this value from your Microsoft Exchange Server administrator.	-
Username	Username for the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express-dedicated e-mail account on the Microsoft Exchange Server.  This username appears in the meeting notifications that are sent to the meeting scheduler.  Example: MeetingPlaceExpress	-
Password	Password for the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express-dedicated e-mail account on the Microsoft Exchange Server.	-
Password confirm	Password for the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express-dedicated e-mail account on the Microsoft Exchange Server.	-

E-mail address	E-mail address of the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express-dedicated e-mail account on the Microsoft Exchange Server.  Example: MeetingPlaceExpress@example.com	-
Mailbox maintenance interval (days)	How often the Microsoft Exchange Server cleans up the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Express-dedicated e-mail account.	Default: 7
Mailbox maintenance cutover (days)	Number of days that notifications are stored in the Microsoft Exchange Server.	Default: 14
