The multiserver meeting feature requires configuration of both the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Audio Server system and Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Web Conferencing. Configuration is therefore completed in both MeetingTime and the Web Conferencing online administrative interface.

To configure the multiserver meeting feature, do the following tasks:

1. Review the [Requirements for Multiserver Meetings](#).
2. Create server information records for the Cisco Unified MeetingPlace Audio Server systems involved in multiserver meetings. This task is completed in MeetingTime.
