You purchase license SKUs with your Cisco Unified MeetingPlace order and install the license file for that order to enable the features and capabilities that you purchased. You may also upgrade your system by purchasing and installing additional licenses. The maximum number of port licenses that you can apply is 2,000 per license.

Use the information in this section to determine if you need to purchase and install additional licenses.

maxvoice	<p>The maxvoice license denotes the maximum number of voice licenses that can be used for meetings on this particular system. languages	<p>The languages license enables the simultaneous use of up to four supported languages on a system. If you do <i>not</i> install the languages license, you can enable only one language.</p>	yes/no
videorecording	<p>The videorecording license allows you to video record meetings. When turned on, it allows the system to video record up to 100 meetings at a time.</p> <p>If you do <i>not</i> install the videorecording license, you cannot video record meetings.</p>	yes/no

jabber	<p>The jabber license enables you to integrate your Cisco Unified MeetingPlace system with Jabber.</p> <p>If you do <i>not</i> install the jabber license, you cannot integrate Cisco Unified MeetingPlace with Jabber.</p>	yes/no
lotusnotes	<p>The lotusnotes license enables you to integrate your Cisco Unified MeetingPlace system with IBM Lotus Notes.</p> <p>If you do <i>not</i> install the lotusnotes license, you cannot integrate Cisco Unified MeetingPlace with IBM Lotus Notes.</p>	yes/no
msft_int	<p>The msft_int license enables you to integrate your Cisco Unified MeetingPlace system with Microsoft Outlook.</p> <p>If you do <i>not</i> install the msft_int license, you cannot integrate Cisco Unified MeetingPlace with Microsoft Outlook.</p>	yes/no
