The table below describes the user and server license requirements for the Cisco Unified Presence MOC call control feature.

Table: Cisco Unified Presence license requirements

License Requirement	Description
Cisco Unified Presence user feature license	<p>You will require a Cisco Unified Presence user license for each MOC call control user. This will consume one Cisco Unified Communications Manager Device License Unit (DLU).</p> <p>On Cisco Unified Communications Manager, you will need to upload the user DLU, and then assign Cisco Unified Presence capabilities for a user.</p>
Cisco Unified Presence server license	<p>You will require one proxy server license for the Cisco Unified Presence server. You must upload this license to the publisher Cisco Unified Presence server.</p>
