

**Configuration: Setting Folder Permissions Failed**

<b>Problem Summary</b>	Failed to set the CUIS folder permissions.
<b>Error Message</b>	Setting Folder Permissions Failed
<b>Possible Cause</b>	The configuration program did not set the folder permissions.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<p>If you see this message, look at the CuisConfigTool.Log file and make every effort to resolve the error based on the information in that file.</p> <p>Only if it is not possible to resolve the matter from information in the CuisConfigTool log, set folder permissions as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In Windows Explorer, navigate to the directory where the web application is stored(&lt;CUIS_HOME&gt;\CuisWeb).</li> <li>2. Make sure that the only permissions that this folder has are the following. (Permissions should apply to the directory and to all subdirectories and files within it.) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>? For users in the <b>CuisLocalUserGroup</b>: <i>read, read and execute, and list directory contents.</i></li> <li>? For users in the <b>Administrators group</b>: <i>full control.</i></li> <li>? For the <b>CUIC windows user</b>: <i>read, write, execute, and list directory contents.</i></li> </ul> </li> </ol>
