

## Configuration: Setting Up Permissions for CUIS SQL Server Login Failed

<b>Problem Summary</b>	Setting Up Permissions for CUIS SQL Server Login Failed
<b>Error Message</b>	Setting Up Permissions for CUIS SQL Server Login Failed
<b>Possible Cause</b>	The CUIS Configuration program did not create the SQL login with the necessary permissions.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<p>If you see this message, look at the CuisConfigTool.Log file and make every effort to resolve the error based on the information in that file.</p> <p>Only if it is not possible to resolve the matter from information in the CuisConfigTool log, manually create a login as follows:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open MS SQL Server. Make sure you are connected as a user who is an administrator in SQL Server and to the master database.</li> <li>2. Open a <b>New Query</b> window.</li> <li>3. Type the following: <b>CREATE LOGIN "&lt;domain&gt;\&lt;username&gt;" FROM WINDOWS</b></li> </ol>
