

## FACT\_select

To select the current scan, use the **select** command.

**select** {*scan*}

### Syntax Description

<i>scan</i>	Identifies the index number of the scan in the scan history that you want to view.
-------------	--

### Command Default

No default behavior or values.

### Usage Guidelines

In the command output, the lowest index number in the "show index" column shows the first scan performed, and the highest number is the latest scan performed.

### Examples

The following example shows that before the **select** command, scan 2 is current. Afterwards, scan 1 is current:

```
fact> show history
```

index	current	type	date	subnet-manager
1		fabric	2008-04-17 10:44:02 PDT	host01
2	Y	tech-support	2008-04-17 10:44:47 PDT	host01

```
fact> select 1
```

```
fact> show history
```

index	current	type	date	subnet-manager
1	Y	fabric	2008-04-17 10:44:02 PDT	host01
2		tech-support	2008-04-17 10:44:47 PDT	host01
