

Windows OS Application Log Fills up

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| Problem Summary | Windows Operating System Application log fills up, and clearing the log only resolves the issue temporarily. |
| Error Message | None |
| Possible Cause | Event log settings are not set to roll over. |
| Recommended Action | <p>Change the Event setting so that the Application Log rolls over by doing the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Select Start > Programs > Administrative Tools > Event Viewer. 2. Right-click Application Log and select Properties from the menu. 3. Select the Overwrite events as needed option. 4. Click Apply and OK. |

| Possible Cause | Some unnecessary protocols might have been installed. For example, NetBEUI has been known to fill the event log. |
