

## Windows OS Application Log Fills up

<b>Problem Summary</b>	Windows Operating System Application log fills up, and clearing the log only resolves the issue temporarily.
<b>Error Message</b>	None
<b>Possible Cause</b>	Event log settings are not set to roll over.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<p>Change the Event setting so that the Application Log rolls over by doing the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select <b>Start &gt; Programs &gt; Administrative Tools &gt; Event Viewer</b>.</li> <li>2. Right-click <b>Application Log</b> and select Properties from the menu.</li> <li>3. Select the <b>Overwrite events as needed</b> option.</li> <li>4. Click <b>Apply</b> and <b>OK</b>.</li> </ol>
<b>Release</b>	Release 7.0(2)
<b>Associated CDETS #</b>	None.
<b>Possible Cause</b>	Some unnecessary protocols might have been installed. For example, NetBEUI has been known to fill the event log.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	Uninstall protocols that are not necessary in this application.
