

## Logger processes crashes after upgrade to SQL Server 2008 R2

<b>Problem Summary</b>	After you upgrade from SQL Server 2005 to SQL Server 2008 R2, the logger processes crashes.
<b>Error Message</b>	from the clgr log: SQL Server User Error: 229, State 5, Severity: 14, Message: The SELECT permission wa
<b>Possible Cause</b>	Missing BUILTIN\Administrators users or missing server role "sysadmin" for BUILTIN\Administrators
<b>Recommended Action</b>	Manually add BUILTIN\Administrators:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open SQL Server Management Studio.</li> <li>2. Go to Security &gt; Logins.</li> <li>3. Add New Login for BUILTIN\Administrators.</li> <li>4. Select 'sysadmin' for Server Roles for BUILTIN\Administrators.</li> </ol>
