| <b>Problem Summary</b>    | In OAMP, when a gateway?s hostname that starts with a number is entered, CVP gives an error message.                                           |
| <b>Error Message</b>      | Hostname is invalid. Valid hostnames contain uppercase and lowercase alphanumeric characters, period, underscore, and dash.                    |
| <b>Possible Cause</b>     | The hostname entered starts with a number. It must start with an alphabet character, not a number.                                             |
| <b>Recommended Action</b> | Check the gateway?s host name. If the hostname starts with a number, change the hostname so that it starts with an alphabet character instead. |
| <b>Release</b>            | 8.0(1), 8.0(2), and 8.5(1)                                                                                                                     |
