

**Recordings from CUBE fail with SIP error 488 Not Acceptable Here**

<b>Problem Summary</b>	Calls forked from CUBE cannot be recorded.
<b>Error Message</b>	SIP traces show Cisco MediaSense receiving the Invite from CUBE, and then rejecting it with <b>SIP/2.0 488 Not Acceptable Here</b> .
<b>Possible Cause</b>	CUBE by default sends multipart Content-Type header to the MediaSense, but MediaSense does not support it. Notice the SIP Invite contains " <b>Content-Type: multipart/mixed;boundary=uniqueBoundary</b> ".
<b>Recommended Action</b>	You can prevent CUBE from sending multipart Content-Type to MediaSense by specifying  <pre>signaling forward none</pre> In the dial-peer to MediaSense.
