


**Reporting: Script slows down the Filter page in Internet Explorer**

<b>Problem Summary</b>	The Filter page, when open in Internet Explorer, is slow and displays a warning when there are more than 1500 system collections with about 15,000 values in them.
<b>Error Message</b>	
<b>Possible Cause</b>	You have exceeded the maximum number of scripts that can be run on the Internet Explorer page.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<p>Do the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1) Go to <b>Start</b> menu &gt; <b>Run</b>.</li> <li>2) Type <b>regedit</b>.</li> <li>3) Open the registry key: <i>HKEY_CURRENT_USER\Software\Microsoft\Internet Explorer\Styles</i>. If the Styles key is not present, create a new key that is called Styles.</li> <li>4) Right click anywhere in the right pane and create a new <b>DWORD</b> value called "<b>MaxScriptStatements</b>".</li> <li>5) Copy and paste that in to the name box and set the value to the desired number of script statements, for example 8000000.</li> </ol>
