

SocialMiner Administration - Sign-in page does not load when XMPP server is down

<p>Problem Summary</p>	<p>Attempt to sign in to SocialMiner using Firefox. The sign-in page does not load. A page with the following message appears:</p> <p>Checking Connectivity...SocialMiner requires an additional untrusted connection.</p> <p>Click Continue and a new tab opens with the following message:</p> <p>Unable to connect...Firefox can't establish a connection to the server at <i><ip address:port></i>.</p>
<p>Error Message</p>	<p>Unable to connect...Firefox can't establish a connection to the server at <i><ip address:port></i>.</p>
<p>Possible Cause</p>	<p>The SocialMiner XMPP Server service is not yet started [STARTING] or the status is [STOPPED].</p>
<p>Recommended Action</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the status of the XMPP Server service is [STARTING], wait for the XMPP Server service to start. • If the status of the XMPP Server service is [STOPPED], access the CLI on the SocialMiner server and start the XMPP Server service (utlis service start SocialMiner XMPP Server).
