

**SocialMiner Filters - Errors saving Groovy scripts**

<b>Problem Summary</b>	You see errors when you import a Groovy script.
<b>Error Message</b>	The User Interface will show this error: ?The following fields are invalid: Script Source: Invalid input? Logs may also show "Unexpected char" errors similar to this:  <code>, Message=startup failed: Script1.groovy: 1: unexpected char: '\'</code> @ line 1, column
<b>Possible Cause</b>	You did not save the file as plain text or the editor you used was not optimized to handle multi-byte characters.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	Edit and save the file as UTF-8. Use a reliable editor such as Eclipse or Notepad++ to edit Groovy scripts. Check to make sure that the file was not saved as "rich text," which will insert special characters. Resave as plain text and retry the Import.
