

SocialMiner Filters - Errors saving Groovy scripts

| Problem Summary | You see errors when you import a Groovy script. |
| Error Message | The User Interface will show this error: ?The following fields are invalid: Script Source: Invalid input? Logs may also show "Unexpected char" errors similar to this: <code>, Message=startup failed: Script1.groovy: 1: unexpected char: '\ ' @ line 1, column</code> |
| Possible Cause | You did not save the file as plain text or the editor you used was not optimized to handle multi-byte characters. |
| Recommended Action | Edit and save the file as UTF-8. Use a reliable editor such as Eclipse or Notepad++ to edit Groovy scripts. Check to make sure that the file was not saved as "rich text," which will insert special characters. Resave as plain text and retry the Import. |
