

## SocialMiner Installation - Two SocialMiner Applications on one Server, Setting CPU Reservation

<b>Problem Summary</b>	You are deploying two SocialMiner applications on one VMWare server.
<b>Error Message</b>	You cannot start the second SocialMiner. You see an error about insufficient CPU resources.
<b>Possible Cause</b>	You are exceeding the CPU capacity.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open the vSphere client and point to the host for the SocialMiner systems.</li> <li>2. Right click on the VM you want to modify and click <b>Edit Virtual Machine Settings</b>.</li> <li>3. Click the Resources tab.</li> <li>4. Make sure <b>CPU</b> is highlighted.</li> <li>5. Change the CPU Reservation to 8000MHz by dragging the arrow or by typing <i>8000</i>.</li> </ol>
