


**System: Retrieve Size for CUIC Database Tables**

<b>Problem Summary</b>	You want to determine the current size of the CUIC database tables.
<b>Error Message</b>	None.
<b>Possible Cause</b>	You are concerned that some tables are growing too large.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	<p>In the SQL Server Management Studio, Open New Query window.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Select the CUIC database.</li> <li>2. Run the following SQL Statement in Query Window: select 'exec sp_spaceused ' + name from sysobjects where type = 'U'.</li> </ol> <p> <b>Note:</b> There is a space after 'spaceused' and the '.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3. Copy the Result of this query.</li> <li>4. Open another new Query Window.</li> <li>5. Paste the query.</li> <li>6. Select the CUIC database.</li> <li>7. Run (execute) the query.</li> </ol> <p>The result of the query displays information about all tables in CUIC database including size and number of rows in the table.</p>
