<b>Problem Summary</b>	The Cisco Unified CCX Historical reports client computer displays the SQL Command Failed dialog box when you try to generate a historical report. This dialog box specifies an error number, <i>n</i> .
<b>Error Message</b>	<i>Error:&lt;number&gt;</i> .
<b>Possible Cause</b>	This error can occur in a variety of situations.
<b>Recommended Action</b>	On the computer on which you received the SQL Command Failed dialog box, open the most recent Historical Reports log file. Search for the error number. The cause of the error will appear near the error number. You can use this information to resolve the problem.
